## 21st Century Cures Act

On December 13, 2016 President Obama signed HR 34, the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Cures Act, which incorporates monumental bipartisan reform of our nation's mental health system. These reforms include a host of Treatment Advocacy Center priorities, including provisions to increase the number of psychiatric beds nationwide, elevate the federal focus on mental illness by creating a federal position of assistant secretary for mental health and substance use disorders and to address the criminalization of untreated mental illness.
