Get free entry to San Mateo County Parks through the Mariposa Program

You may be eligible for a free San Mateo County Park pass through the Mariposa Program, a partnership of San Mateo County's Parks Department and the Human Services Agency (HSA).

Where can I use the park pass?

The park pass is good for 12 months, and covers the \$6 entrance fee to these San Mateo County Parks:

- San Bruno Mountain in Brisbane
- Junipero Serra Park in San Bruno
- Coyote Point Recreation Area in San Mateo
- Huddart Park in Woodside
- San Pedro Valley Park in Pacifica
- Sam McDonald Park in Loma Mar
- Memorial Park in Loma Mar

Am I eligible for this program?

San Mateo County residents who are enrolled in these programs are eligible for a park pass:

- Medi-Cal
- CalFresh
- CalWORKS
- San Mateo County Access and Care for Everyone (ACE)

How can I request a free park pass?

1. Call San Mateo County's Human Services Agency at **(650) 508-3200** and leave your name and phone number.
2. An HSA specialist will call you back.
3. Once your eligibility is confirmed, the Parks Department will mail your park pass. It can take up to two weeks for the pass to arrive.

If you're not enrolled in one of the programs listed above, you can get free entry to a San Mateo County Park if:

- You check out a park pass at a San Mateo County Library
- You are a veteran and show proof of veteran status
- You are a senior (62+) (free entry Monday–Friday, non-holidays)
- Your vehicle displays disabled plates/placards
